




# **RULES AND REGULATIONS**



- ▶ A false start is not allowed.
- Players should be at square to the table.
- ▶ The winner will be decided by best out of 3 falls.











## CHESS

▶ Normal game conditions will be used



### CROSS COUNTRY

- ▶ 2.5 km of race.
- No hurdles.
- ▶ The decision of the referee will be final.






- ▶ 3 minutes will be given to each team in court. The team to spend more time in court will win the match.
- > The decision of the referee will be final.






- Each team shall comprise of 7 players + 3 substitutes.
- ◆ Total time of match shall be 30 minutes (each half of 15 minutes).
- If the match is a draw, the results will be decided on penalties.
- The decision of referees will be final.
- Matches will be held on knockout basis.





- ▶ 40 meters (2 laps of 20 meters each).
- ▶ Violation of swimming style will lead to disqualification.
- ▶ The decision of the referee will be final.






#### THROW BALL

- ▶ Each team shall comprise of 7 players + 3 substitutes.
- ▶ A match will consist of best of 3 sets of 10 points each.
- ▶ The team that scores a point gets the right to serve the following point.
- ▶ A player cannot jump while serving the ball.
- A player cannot jump while throwing the ball
- Double touch while catching the ball will not be allowed.
- The service ball must not touch the net.







- ▶ Each team shall comprise of 7 active members
  - + 3 substitutes.
- ► Each team/ player should be in proper uniform during the match/event.
- ▶ The decision of the judges will be final.
- ▶ Matches will be played on best of 3 bases.





- The referee can halt play for any particular event for any unforeseen or accidental occurrences.
- The referee's word/decision will be the final decision for all games and there shall be no resistance to that.
- Any equipment that a player wears or uses to play (headgear, body guards, studs, aluminum bats etc.) will not be allowed if it is found injurious or unfair to the other team.
- ▶ Every team must be present at least 20 minutes before their game. The referees will wait for a maximum of 15 minutes after which the team will be disqualified and a walk over will be given to the team which is present.
- ▶ Any abusive or void arguments with the referee can lead to disqualification.
- ▶ Only the coach or the captain can speak to the referee during the play for any inquiries.

#### **CODE OF CONDUCT**

- All participants must respect the school's property and must not damage any school's item.
  All participants must observe discipline and mutual respect for the referee and the opposing
- team.
- There are strict rules against smoking during the event.
- Misbehavior with the referee, participants or the people in charge will not be tolerated and will result in disqualification.
- All participants must wear their name cards provided by the management before the event.



- An institution can send as many teams as it wants.
- ▶ If a player has more than one competitions going on at the same time, he/she must report to the referee or the people in- charge of the particular event.
- ▶ Each institution can send a maximum of 5 supporters, the name of the supporters should be given with the registration form.
- Participants will be informed of the timings, venues and the dates of their matches/events.
- The referee's decision will be final. No arguments will be tolerated. Violation of rules and misconduct will result in disqualification.
- A closing ceremony will be held on the last day of the event for winners and the runner-ups, details of which will be disclosed later.
